WINEMAKER NOTE

Essentially this is the reserve shiraz. Sourced entirely from estate vineyards. Shiraz is arguably the region's best red variety. Shiraz and viognier are co-fermented in small batches. Shiraz may be back blended to achieve the right balance. There is a limited amount of new oak.

TASTING NOTE

Medium-bodied and fine-boned in structure. There is a fineness and elegance to this wine that is almost the antithesis of Australian Shiraz. Perfumed red berries, spice, some charcuterie, soft integrated oak showing as hints of choc-vanilla and cedar. Viognier pokes its head through to give a lifted floral complexity. Lively acid provides backbone and fine tannins provide length.

CELLARING

Up to 10 years. We expect this to evolve beautifully in the cellar.
